Fake News Quiz

Learning objective:

Understanding and recognizing fake news in our daily life. Testing your ability to detect disinformation.

Duration:

5 - 10 minutes

Players:

1-10 players, play by yourself or challenge your friends!

It is most suitable for students between 12 – 18 who use social media daily but maybe can't filter the information in a critical way. But feel free to do the quiz to test yourself whatever your age.

Vocabulary:

Below is some vocabulary used in this quiz that may be helpful to review before and after playing!

- Chemtrails: The long-lasting condensation trails that are left by airplanes in the sky. People believe that the long-lasting condensation trails (chemtrails) have some additional substances because they don't disappear fast, like normal condensation does. These additional substances are supposed to be chemical or biological and have effects on people.
- Conspiracy theory: a belief that some secret but influential organization is responsible for an event or phenomenon

Useful definitions:

- Disinformation: false, deceptive information designed to influence opinions in order to create the appearance of credibility
- Hoax: in online communications, an unsolicited message that aims to trick or spread false and often preposterous information
